Continued Presence (CP) is a temporary immigration designation provided to individuals identified by law enforcement as victims of a "severe form of trafficking persons" who may be potential witnesses in an investigation or who have filed civil actions against their traffickers.


CONTINUED PRESENCE AT A GLANCE




Continued Presence is requested for identified victims of human trafficking that have no lawful immigration status.




Continued Presence is applied for upon identification of a trafficking victim who may be a potential witness.




Continued Presence is available to victims of both sex and labor trafficking.



Continued Presence is valid for two years with potential for renewal.

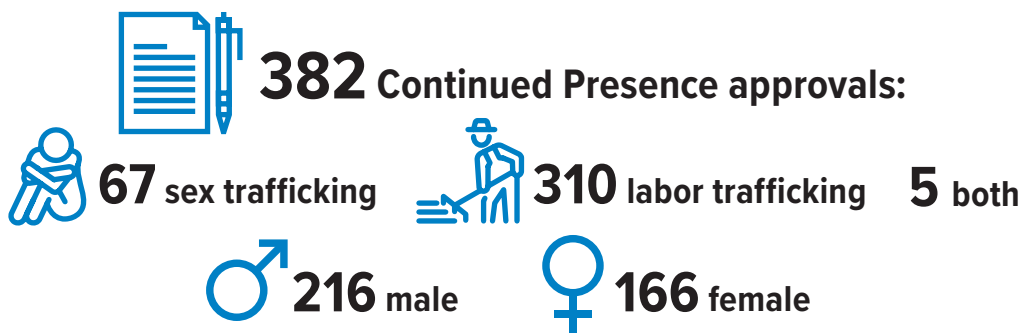


Continued Presence allows for recipients to remain and lawfully work in the United States.



Continued Presence recipients are eligible to receive federal benefits and services.
