## Activities for the Classroom

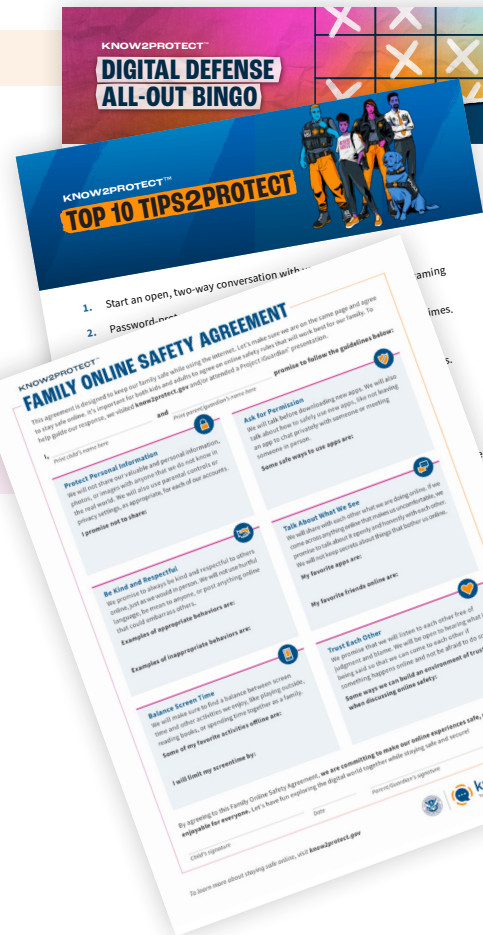
