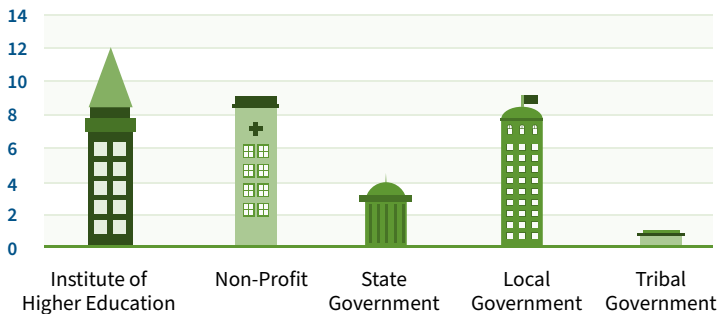

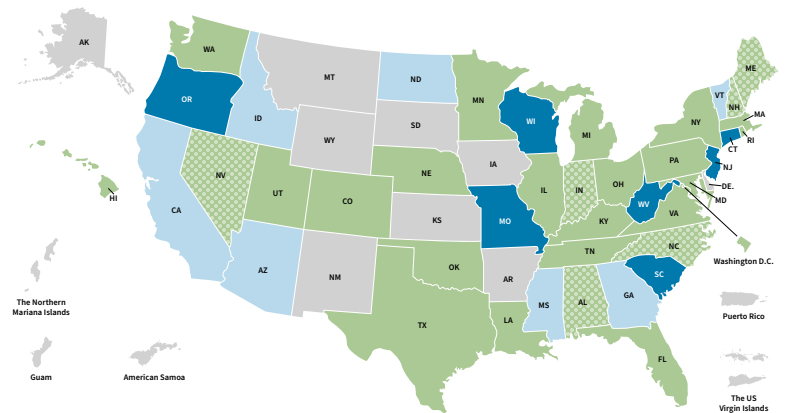

Awarded States: Past to Present

The FY 2024 package includes awards in 6 new states and territories that have not had a grant award previously: Alabama, Indiana, Maine, Nevada, New Hampshire and North Carolina. In addition, one award in Hawaii will work to establish a behavioral threat assessment and management program in Guam. This brings the total of awarded states throughout the history of the program to 41 states and the District of Columbia.
