



X-Ray Systems and Services

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) established three (3) Blanket Purchase Agreements (BPAs), to acquire a wide range of small scale non-intrusive X-ray systems, accessories, maintenance, and related services. This vehicle is intended to assist DHS Contracting Officers (CO), jointly referred to as the Ordering Activity, in acquiring X-ray systems and related services. These BPAs were competitively awarded focusing on prime manufacture products with a comprehensive list of related services to include pricing for products, training, engineering support services, delivery/shipping, extended warranties, and installation, relocation, disposal, maintenance, configuration management, and ancillary equipment.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- These BPAs were developed based on input from across the department through the DHS Strategic Sourcing X-Ray IPT;
- Three sizes of X-Ray Systems are available [Baggages/Packages; Large Parcel; and Pallets] with either Single-view or Multi-view capabilities;
- Utilizes DHS FAR Deviation 21-02, with allows streamlined ordering up to \$7.5 million, pursuant to with FAR Part 13; and
- Provide a one-stop solution for acquiring the approved X-Ray systems, accessories, training, services, and maintenance.

One-year base period, plus four one-year option periods (2/01/2023 – 1/31/2028)
