

## **DHS Small Business Vendor Outreach Sessions**

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) will host a Vendor Outreach Session (VOS). This session is for all Small Businesses.

The VOS provide small businesses with the platform to discuss their capabilities and learn about DHS procurements and large business subcontracting and partnering opportunities.

Counselors for VOS include representatives from DHS Headquarters Office of Procurement Operations (OPO), Customs and Border Protection (CBP), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Federal Law Enforcement Training Centers (FLETC), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Transportation Security Administration (TSA), U.S. Coast Guard (USCG), United States Citizen & Immigration Services (USCIS), U.S. Secret Service (USSS) and the Small Business Innovation Research Program (SBIR). Large business counselors will discuss various areas of collaboration to include subcontracting opportunities, joint ventures, and mentor-protégé program relationships.

NOTE: if you have previously met with a DHS component within the last three months, please consider this before registering for any VOS. Direct contact with the component small business specialists to schedule a follow-up discussion outside of VOS is preferred. This allows more opportunities for other small businesses who have not met with DHS to request a meeting and discuss their capabilities.
