

5.56 Duty Rifle

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) established a consolidated, Department-wide Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract to procure 5.56 Duty Rifles and parts. The contract includes various barrel lengths, semi and select fire lowers, and all required parts.

This IDIQ is a Firm-Fixed Price (FFP) contract vehicle.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Enables DHS Components to leverage collective buying power through a simplified, expedited and lower cost method of procurement;
- Increases consistency of firearm performance due to a standard quality assurance process;
- Rifles are compatible with the Optics and Operational Light Systems Strategic Sourcing Vehicles (SSVs); and
- Provides Multiple barrel lengths and rates of fire to meet most mission specific needs.

Period of Performance (POP):

- Five-year base, 09/30/2022 9/29/2027.
- Delivery dates up to twelve months past the end of the POP.
