



Personal Ballistic Plate Armor (PBPA)

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) awarded an Indefinite Delivery/ Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract for Ballistic Plate Armor. Three variations of the National Institute of Justice (NIJ) plates are included and vary depending upon intended use and threat requirements. This contract is available for use by all DHS Components. Other federal agencies may request order authorization from the IDIQ Contracting Officer.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Freezes Ballistic Plate Armor pricing for the length of the contract;
- Provides a ten-year warranty reducing life cycle costs;
- Produces significant cost savings from commercial pricing;
- Meets National Institute of Justice (NIJ) certified Level III ballistic protection in support of the mission of officers and agents;
- Supplies armor that is certified by the NIJ's Compliance Testing Program and listed on the NIJ's current Compliance Product List for NIJ Standard 0101.06;
- Includes plates that are serialized, and all orders include serial number reporting requirements; and
- Delivers pre-established terms & conditions and well-defined ordering processes, which enable contracting officers to efficiently fill requirements.
